The Monterey County Resource Management Agency - Public Works & Facilities announces that the Cachagua Storm Damage Repair Project will begin October 9, 2017. The project consists of the construction of a reinforced soil slope embankment and road reconstruction. The project is expected to be completed by the end of January 2018. The road will be closed for several weeks during the construction of the project. Construction area signage will be installed to direct motorist around this section of Cachagua Road. The Cachagua Road Emergency Repair Project will have a construction cost of approximately \$1,736,000 which will be funded with Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), California State Office of Emergency Services (CALOES) and local Monterey County Funds.
