Emergency treatments to limit the risk of disability are available but underutilized.

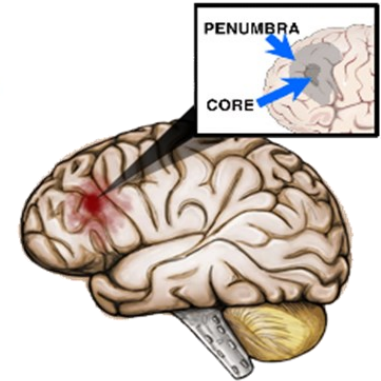
