TRESPASSING ENFORCEMENT AUTHORIZATION

Penal Code 602(n)(2) provides for authorization only under two circumstances: fire hazard and absence of the owner from the property. This form, when filled out completely and signed by the property owner, authorizes the Monterey County Sheriff's Office to act as the owner's agent to enforce trespassing laws. This authorization will not cover guests of residents on the property or lawful labor union activities. It limits the authorization to no more than six months and states that the property must be closed to the public and posted as such. The owner must complete a new authorization each time the old one expires to keep the authorization in effect.
