SEASIDE MAN FOUND GUILTY OF BRANDISHING A DEADLY WEAPON

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Narcisco Luna-Lopez, age 42, was found guilty by a jury of brandishing a deadly weapon. The case was heard by Monterey County Superior Court Judge Mark Hood.

On December 4, 2015 Luna-Lopez approached John Doe 1 & 2 on Roberts Avenue in Seaside. Luna-Lopez inquired about available work. During the conversation, Luna-Lopez became angry. John Doe 2 saw Luna-Lopez draw a 9-inch knife from inside his jacket and aggressively approach John Doe 1 in a threatening manner. John Doe 1 saw Luna-Lopez approach with the knife and ran to call the police. Luna-Lopez hid the knife on top of a tire inside the wheel well of his car, where it was later located by Seaside Police officers.

Luna-Lopez will be sentenced by Judge Hood on January 13, 2016. He faces a maximum of one year in the county jail. Officers Dan Charlton and Anthony Snell of the Seaside Police Department investigated this matter.
