**PASO ROBLES WOMAN FOUND GUILTY OF
POSSESSING CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Angelicas Potillo, age 20, and a resident of Paso Robles, was convicted by jury on March 23, 2016, of possessing methamphetamine.

Potillo was stopped just before midnight on December 23, 2015, by Marina Police Department officers for driving with one headlight. Potillo was a passenger in her own car. Officer Garica smelled the odor of burnt marijuana, and located methamphetamine next to a marijuana pipe in the center console of Potillo's car.

Potillo was sentenced to three years of probation and 30 days in the Monterey County jail. The investigation was conducted by Chayene Garcia of the Marina Police Department.
