TENNESSEE MAN FOUND GUILTY OF DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that on June 30, 2016, Scott Roberts, age 49, was found guilty by jury of driving under the influence of alcohol and driving with 0.08 percent blood alcohol. The case was heard by Monterey County Superior Court Judge Larry E. Hayes.

On September 15, 2015, at 2:15 a.m. in Marina, Roberts was driving his vehicle and made an unsafe turning movement in front of a Marina police officer's patrol vehicle. The officer stopped Roberts' vehicle, contacted him, and immediately smelled the odor of alcohol on Roberts' person. A DUI investigation followed. Roberts' blood alcohol level was .11%.

Judge Hayes sentenced the defendant to 10 days in county jail and five years of probation. Sergeant Bryan Whittaker and Officer Vincent Troia of the Marina Police Department investigated this matter.
