SAN FRANCISCO MAN FOUND GUILTY BY JURY OF BATTERY

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Adam Jeter, 28 years old, of San Francisco, was convicted of battery by a jury, before the Honorable Judge Julie Culver.

On April 27, 2016, the defendant, unprovoked, kicked a woman in the stomach, while she was walking on the recreation trail above Cannery Row. She was with another parent, on a field trip with two classes from a Watsonville elementary school.

The case was investigated by Officer Brent Hall of the Monterey Police Department. Ramos will be sentenced in Department 5 on August 2, 2016. The Defendant faces six months in jail.
