MARINA WOMAN PLEADS GUILTY TO BRINGING METHAMPHETAMINE AND MARIJUANA TO JAIL

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Shirley Ann George, age 41, has pled guilty to the charge of possession of methamphetamine and marijuana in a jail facility. Ms. George was sentenced by Judge Pamela L. Butler to three years and eight months in state prison.

On January 1, 2016, Ms. George entered the Monterey County Jail visiting area requesting to visit an inmate. Deputies located two baggies of methamphetamine and one bag of marijuana in her possession.

The case was investigated by Monterey County Sheriff's Deputies Blaine Councilman and M. Kimble.
