GREENFIELD MAN SENTENCED TO TWO YEARS PRISON

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Cameron Clark, age 23, was sentenced by Monterey Superior Court Judge Julie Culver to two years in state prison. Clark had previously pleaded guilty to one felony count of possession of contraband in prison. Clark also received a sentence of 488 days on violations of probation in five misdemeanor cases.

On August 7, 2016 while in custody at the Monterey County jail, the defendant was found to have secreted in his person .18 grams of heroin.

The felony case was investigated by Deputy Pantoja of the Monterey County Sheriff's Office.
