## **GREENFIELD MAN RECEIVES ONE YEAR JAIL SENTENCE FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND CHILD ENDANGERMENT**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Greenfield resident Zacarias Vasquez, age 29, was convicted of battery on a spouse and child endangerment.

The domestic violence incident occurred in October 2016 at the home of the defendant and victim. Vasquez head-butted the victim in the face twice and punched her multiple times as their 11-year-old daughter attempted to pull him off.

Vasquez received a jail sentence of 1 year with 180 days suspended. He was sentenced on November 9, 2016 before Monterey County Superior Court Judge Efrain Iglesias.

The case was investigated by Greenfield Police Department Officer Christopher Webb.
