MONTEREY MAN TO RECEIVE 3 YEAR PRISON SENTENCE FOR BURGLARY

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that David Custus, age 31, entered a plea of no contest to second degree burglary. Custus also admitted serving a prior prison term for possession of child pornography.

On September 27, 2016, Custus was observed on surveillance video prowling around the area of 9825 Blue Larkspur Lane. Custus was seen walking the halls of the business located at that address and leaving with a backpack that he did not enter with. An employee reported his backpack, which contained his laptop, missing. Custus was arrested on September 28, 2016 and was in possession of the victim's personal items.

Custus will receive a sentence of 3 years in state prison. He is scheduled to be sentenced on December 14, 2016 before Monterey County Superior Court Judge Andrew Liu.
