


Nonprofit charitable organizations are entitled to 4 fee exemptions per fiscal year (July 1- June 30) for fund raising events that do not exceed 72 hours each. To apply for fee exemption please submit the request on your organizations letterhead at least 10 business days prior to event with the following information:

1. Date & times of event
2. Description of event
3. Location of event
4. Nonprofit federal ID number
5. Menu items
6. Contact person & phone number
7. Please note if you would like a scheduled inspection.

Organizations agree to comply with all California Retail Food Code requirements for the operation of temporary food facilities.

Choice #1

Purchase an annual TFF permit for unlimited events throughout Monterey County for the fiscal year.

Choice #2


Purchase a permit for a single event based on the number of days the event is held. See current fee schedule below.

Participating non profit charitable temporary food facilities (TFF) may operate up to four (4) times annually. Each event shall not exceed 72 hours. (CalCode 114332.1)

Non Profit charity event organizers are entitled to four (4) fee exemptions per fiscal year (July 1-June 30). Exemption is granted on proof of approved IRS nonprofit status.

When a non profit receives 4 exemptions in a fiscal year, participation will be with a reduced fee permit.

For profit vendors may have a fee waiver if the for profit vendor receives no monetary benefit from a non profit event.
