MONTEREY WOMAN TO RECEIVE TWO YEAR PRISON SENTENCE FOR RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Jennifer Cormier, age 43, entered a plea of no contest to residential burglary.

On September 8, 2016, Cormier entered the victim's apartment while he was doing laundry. When the victim returned, he saw Cormier attempting to take his video gaming system. Monterey Police Department officers located and arrested Cormier. The officers found several tools used to commit burglaries in her backpack.

Cormier will receive a sentence of two years in state prison. She is scheduled to be sentenced on January 13, 2017 before Monterey County Superior Court Judge Andrew Liu.
