## **SACRAMENTO MAN GETS PRISON TERM FOR BREAKING STRANGER'S CLAVICLE**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Tyler David Misamore, age 23 of Sacramento, was sentenced to three years in state prison on Tuesday for battery causing serious bodily injury. Misamore was sentenced by Monterey Superior Court Judge Carrie M. Panetta.

On October 8, 2016, Misamore got into an argument with a married couple eating outdoors at a Monterey restaurant. Misamore began to yell at the man and called the wife multiple profane names. When the couple asked Misamore to leave them alone, he sucker-punched the husband twice and took him to the ground, breaking his clavicle. Misamore then fled the scene, but was located nearby.

Misamore was sentenced to three years in state prison. At the time of the offense, he was on felony probation for inflicting corporal injury to a dating partner and misdemeanor cruelty to animals.

The case was investigated by Officer Russell Jenkins of the Monterey Police Department.
