TWO MEN CONVICTED FOR RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY IN PRUNEDALE

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that, Norman Bolcao, age 34, and Matthew Wilhelm, age 27, entered pleas of no contest to residential burglary. Bolcao also pled no contest to one count of felony domestic violence. Wilhelm entered an additional no contest plea to possession of narcotics in the Monterey County Jail.

On February 21, 2016 Bolcao and Wilhelm broke into a home where the victim was house-sitting. Bolcao confronted the victim and demanded her phone and some valuable coins. The victim screamed, causing Bolcao to leave. Wilhelm's boot print was found on the garage door, which had been kicked in. Bolcao and Wilhelm were detained in a vehicle together near the scene.

Bolcao was sentenced to 4 years in state prison. Wilhelm will also be sentenced to 4 years in state prison. He is scheduled to be sentenced on January 20, 2017 before Monterey County Superior Court Judge Andrew Liu.
