Sample Manure Management Plan

1. All roosters and any pens/cages housing roosters will be protected from unnecessary accumulation of manure that leads to odors, flies or runoff during rain events.
2. Accumulated manure from roosters or hens or any other fowl will either be:
 - Composted on site in a contained area (soil berm) to eliminate runoff in a rain event.
 - Disposed of properly in solid waste containers for weekly disposal by the County Solid Waste Hauler. Receipts for Solid Waste services will be provided.
3. Accumulated manure from dogs, cats or livestock will either be:
 - Disposed of properly in solid waste containers for weekly disposal by the County Solid Waste Hauler. Receipts for Solid Waste services will be provided.
 - Hauled off to the landfill for disposal. Tipping fee receipts from the landfill will be maintained to document proper disposal.
4. Accumulated manure will be kept in closed containers or covered and kept in a soil berm to limit odors, flies and proliferation of maggots.
5. Accumulated manure shall not be stored in an area where run off may impact surface waters or storm drains.
