SEASIDE MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO FORGERY

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that on January 3, 2017 Miguel Perez, age 40, pled guilty to possession of a forged driver's license and forgery.

On September 15, 2016 Monterey County Sheriff's Deputies conducted a traffic stop on a 2005 black Mercedes Benz because the registration tags were expired. Perez was a passenger in that vehicle. Upon contacting Perez the deputies learned that he was currently on probation. The deputies conducted a probation compliance check on Perez and discovered he had a forged California driver's license and forged checks.

Monterey County Superior Court Judge Julie R. Culver will sentence Perez on January 17, 2017 to 2 years 8 months in prison that will be served in the county jail due to Realignment.
