

# Enroll in Health Insurance Now

- or face an IRS penalty -

## Open Enrollment ends January 31

**You may get financial help to pay for coverage- it's based on income and 4 out of 5 people who have enrolled qualify.**

Most people are required to have health insurance or pay a tax penalty. In 2016 the penalty will be 2.5% of your yearly household income or \$695 per adult up to \$2,085 per family, whichever is higher.

#### Self-Pay Discounts Program/ Charity Care Program

Natividad Medical Center offers various options where patients pay a reduced portion of their NMC bills.

#### Breast and Cervical Cancer Treatment Program

Treatment and follow up care available to individuals diagnosed with breast and/or cervical cancer.

#### Hospital Presumptive Eligibility (HPE)

Provides immediate temporary, no-cost Medi-Cal benefits for up to 2 months while putting patients on a path to coverage.

#### Presumptive Eligibility for Pregnant Women

Provides immediate coverage for 2 months for low income pregnant women while they apply for Medi-Cal, including Restricted Medi-Cal

#### Restricted Medi-Cal Programs

Available to individuals who are ineligible for Medi-Cal but who require medical attention due to a medical emergency.

#### Pilot Project (for the uninsured)

Covers limited laboratory, radiology and pharmacy services for people at, or under 138% of the Federal Poverty Level.

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
