Monterey County's Remaining Uninsured Pilot Project

The Pilot Project is not health insurance, but rather offers residents of Monterey County who do not qualify for existing medical plans and do not earn more than 138% of the Federal Poverty level a way to cover certain pharmacy services from Walgreens, and specific laboratory and radiology services from Natividad Medical Center. Please note the pilot is temporary and based on available funds. Full-scope Medi-Cal for Undocumented Children

Medi-Cal is free or low-cost health coverage for children and families with limited incomes. Undocumented children and youth under 19 whose families meet the income guidelines qualify for Full-scope Medi-Cal. The coverage includes preventive care for medical, dental, vision, and mental health services.
