SANTA CLARA MAN CONVICTED OF FALSE IMPERSONATION

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Santa Clara resident Angelo Amir Henry, age 27, was convicted by a jury of false impersonation and driving on a suspended license.

The incident occurred in March 2016 at the Monterey Regional Airport. Henry failed to stop at a stop sign and when he was contacted by police, he gave the name of Ismael Pugh, a friend of his. He maintained that his name was Pugh through many questions by the officer and signed his name as Pugh on a traffic citation for not having a driver's license in his possession.

The case was investigated by Monterey Peninsula Airport District Police Department Officers Alfred Porter and Gary Anderson.
