## **MARINA MAN RECIEVES 2 YEAR PRISON SENTENCE FOR DRUG SALES AND ILLEGALLY POSSESSING A FIREARM**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Nhan Boi Phan, age 25 of Marina, was sentenced by Judge Julie R. Culver to 2 years in the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation after pleading guilty to possession of prescription pills for sale and felon in possession of a firearm.

On September 27, 2016 Marina Police officers responded to Phan's residence on a report of a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival they located 3 plastic bags that contained 1,460 Xanax pills, two digital scales, a pill press with dye and a semi-automatic handgun in Phan's bedroom. Phan is prohibited from possessing any firearms based on a prior felony conviction.
