## **SALINAS MAN RECEIVES 2 YEAR PRISON SENTENCE FOR ASSAULT**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that on April 12, 2017, Salinas resident Juan Carlos Fraide, age 34, was sentenced to 2 years in the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation by Monterey County Superior Court Judge Andrew Liu.

On March 8, 2017, Fraide entered a plea of no contest to assault with force likely to cause great bodily injury. On October 23, 2016, he attacked a volunteer at Dorothy's Kitchen with a pair of scissors. The victim had asked Fraide not to ingest narcotics in the doorway to Dorothy's Kitchen. He responded violently, trying to stab the victim with the scissors. Luckily, the victim was able to escape and was not injured.

The case was investigated by the Salinas Police Department.
