## **GREENFIELD MAN SENTENCED TO 4 YEARS IN PRISON FOR ATTEMPTED ROBBERY**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Greenfield resident Douglas Icabaceta, age 31, previously entered a plea of no contest to attempted robbery on March 29, 2017.

The incident occurred in August 2016 at the McDonald's in Greenfield. Icabaceta demanded money from the drive through window employee. When the employee refused to comply, Icabaceta stabbed him four times with a screwdriver. Other employees were able to subdue him until officers arrived.

Icabaceta received a prison sentence of 4 years in state prison on May 3, 2017 from Monterey County Superior Court Judge Pamela Butler.

The case was investigated by Greenfield Police Department Officer C. Webb, with the assistance of several other officers.
