## **SALINAS WOMAN SENTENCED TO 2 YEARS IN PRISON FOR ASSAULT LIKELY TO CAUSE GREAT BODILY INJURY**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Salinas resident Kris Adducci, age 43, previously entered pleas of no contest to assault with force likely to produce great bodily injury and shoplifting on April 5, 2017.

The incident occurred in August 2016 at a CVS store in Salinas. Adducci entered the establishment and concealed multiple items in her bag. When she was confronted by loss prevention personnel, she immediately began striking them with her fists and scratching them. A nearby Salinas police officer was waved down and arrested her.

Adducci received a prison sentence of 2 years in state prison on May 3, 2017 from the Monterey County Superior Court Judge Pamela Butler.

The case was investigated by Salinas Police Department Officers Nicholas Grave and Scott Gemette.
