

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING A TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF FUNDS
(TAX ANTICIPATION LOAN)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Monterey County Regional Fire Protection District of Monterey County finds that, until its tax revenue is received, it will not have sufficient funds to pay its obligations incurred for maintenance purposes in the current fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, its funds are in the custody of the treasurer of the County of Monterey and are paid out solely through his office;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to Article 13, Section 25 of the California Constitution, the treasurer of the County of Monterey is requested to make a temporary transfer to said district, from the funds in his custody, in the sum of \$5,000,000.00, which is necessary to provide funds for meeting obligations incurred for the following maintenance purposes by said district, to wit:

FURTHER RESOLVED that Michael B. Urquides is authorized and directed to make and sign a request for said transfer and to send a certified copy of the resolution to the county treasurer.





REQUEST AND CERTIFICATION FOR TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF FUNDS


