GREENFIELD MAN SENTENCED TO PRISON FOR ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF AMMUNITION

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Jesus Ivan Heredia, age 33, a resident of Greenfield, has been sentenced to 16 months in prison for possessing ammunition after having previously been convicted of a felony.

On July 20, 2017, Heredia was pulled over on his bicycle by Greenfield Police Officer Justin Mattke after he failed to stop at a stop sign. During the stop, Heredia consented to a search of his person and Officer Mattke located a live round of ammunition for a .22 caliber shotgun in Heredia's front pocket. Heredia had previously been convicted of felony burglary in 2003 and felony possession of a controlled substance in 2013, making it illegal for him to be in possession of the ammunition.

Judge Julie R. Culver sentenced Heredia to 16 months in the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation for his crime.
