## **SEASIDE MAN RECEIVES PRISON SENTENCE FOR RESIDENTIAL BURGLARIES**

District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that on August 17, 2017 Yefry Mata-Diaz, age 20 of Seaside, was sentenced to four years in prison for first-degree residential burglary, which he committed while he was on probation for another first-degree residential burglary.

On May 14, 2017, Mata-Diaz was caught trying to force a neighbor's window open with a screwdriver. He had unsuccessfully attempted to pry open the door before he tried to go in through the window. At the time, Mata-Diaz was on probation for breaking into another home in 2015.

Mata-Diaz was sentenced by Monterey Superior Court Judge Carrie M. Panetta. The case was investigated by Seaside Police Department Officer Kevin Miller.
