## **SEASIDE WOMAN FOUND GUILTY FOR POSSESSING DRUGS IN THE JAIL**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that a Monterey County jury found Michelle Marie Headrick, of Seaside, guilty of possessing methamphetamine in the Monterey County Jail in violation of Penal Code Section 4573.6(a), a felony.

Seaside police officers arrested Ms. Headrick on the morning of June 7, 2017, based on a misdemeanor warrant. During a strip search at the Monterey County Jail, deputies discovered Headrick had hidden methamphetamine on her person.

The case is scheduled for sentencing before Judge Pamela Butler on October 20, 2017. Ms. Headrick faces a maximum penalty of up to four years in the Monterey County Jail.

Deputies Dorothy Thomas, Sonya Gutierrez, and Patricia Osuna of the Monterey County Sheriff's Office conducted the investigation. Officer Jose Silonsochilt of the Seaside Police Department conducted the initial arrest.
