Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo urges Monterey County residents who were present and experienced emotional and physical losses during the shooting at the Las Vegas Route 91 Harvest Festival shooting on Sunday, October 1, to contact our office. We may be able to help you pay for expenses such as medical bills, funeral expenses, mental health treatment, or lost wages.

You may apply for help whether or not you were injured in the attack. Even if you have no expenses today, we encourage you to apply now in the event you incur expenses in the future. Please call the Monterey County District Attorney's Office, Victim's Unit at 831-755-5072 for assistance.

The FBI is compiling a list of everyone who was at the festival during the attack.
