GREENFIELD MAN FOUND GUILTY BY JURY OF POSSESSING AND DISTRIBUTING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Brandon Conner, age 32, a resident of Greenfield, was found guilty by jury of possessing and distributing child pornography.

Between March 12, 2015, and March 16, 2015, Mr. Conner used peer-to-peer file sharing software to upload and share numerous videos containing child pornography. During an initial search of Mr. Conner's home computer, no child pornography was found; however, a subsequent forensic review of the hard-drive revealed evidence directly linking Mr. Conner to the illegal child pornographic file sharing.

Judge Andrew Liu presided over the trial. Sentencing is scheduled for Wednesday, November 29, 2017. Mr. Conner faces a maximum of 3 years and 8 months in prison.

District Attorney Investigators Steve Guidi and Natalie Dill investigated this case. And San Jose Police Detective Sean Pierce also assisted in this investigation and trial.
