Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that on February 9, 2018, Julie Kathryn Haskell, age 51, and a resident of San Carlos, California was found guilty of driving with a blood alcohol of .08% or greater after a four-day jury trial.

On December 27, 2016, at about 10:00pm, Ms. Haskell was stopped by CHP for speeding in a residential area of Pebble Beach. CHP Officer Matthew Babcock immediately smelled a strong odor of alcoholic beverage which led to a full DUI investigation. Haskell failed various field sobriety tests and was administered a roadside breath test which measured .10 % alcohol. She was arrested, given another breath test an hour later which measured .08%, then booked into the Monterey County Jail.

Ms. Haskell will be sentenced on February 23, 2018 by Judge Rafael Vasquez, She faces up to 5 years probation, license restrictions, and up to 6 months in jail.
