SEASIDE MAN SENTENCED TO PRISON FOR ASSAULT WITH A GOLF CLUB

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Sean Deshand Hand, age 27, a resident of Seaside was sentenced to prison for the crime of assault with force likely to cause great bodily injury.

On May 7, 2017, a party was being held at a Seaside residence and, at 2 a.m., the victim and his roommates were asking people to leave. Hand became upset when asked to leave, left the party, but immediately return armed with a golf club. Hand confronted the victim on the front lawn of the residence and struck him several times with the golf club. The victim was transported to CHOMP where he was treated for swelling and lacerations.

The Honorable Pamela L. Butler sentenced Hand to 3 years in prison for his conduct. As part of his sentence, Hand was also ordered to pay \$8,170.70 to compensate the victim for his hospital bills.

This case was investigated by Officers Troia, Moreno, Solis, and Andrade of the Marina Police Department.
