Interim, Inc. works closely with MCHD BHB to help individuals who are not currently receiving services from the public behavioral healthcare system to obtain psychiatric medications and other needed medical services. The program works closely with the DSS to help individuals enroll in benefits, including SSI.<br>Provides a "Full Service Partnership (FSP) Model," which includes outreach, intensive integrated services and housing for homeless adults with mental illness. MCHOME has some transitional and permanent housing dedicated to the program. In addition, MCHOME manages the Shelter Care 2 program, which has 14 housing vouchers to rent studio or one bedroom units in the community. As those vouchers provide limited funds, Interim Inc has been subsidizing them with donations. MCHOME program also works with clients not yet housed who may be in shelters, on the streets, or in treatment programs. MCHOME provides intensive services to about 70 clients per year, and outreach to about 100. Clients in outreach don't receive case management.
