CASTROVILLE MAN PLEADS NO CONTEST TO CONTINUOUS SEXUAL ABUSE OF A CHILD AND WILL SERVE 14 YEARS IN PRISON

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Alejandro Lusino Garcia, a resident of Castroville, entered a plea of no contest to sexually abusing a child. The defendant will serve a 14-year prison term as part of this plea, and he will be required to register as a sex offender following his release from prison.

Garcia admitted to sexually abusing Jane Doe beginning when she was just 5-years old. Twelve years later when Doe was 17 years old, she reported the abuse to law enforcement.

Judge Culver presided over the entry of plea. District Attorney Investigator Jorge Ramirez, Monterey County Sheriff Deputy Matthew Staley, and Detective Javier Galvan assisted in investigating this case.
