CARMEL VALLEY MAN FOUND GUILTY OF DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that Angel Tomas Casas-Ramirez, age 20, a resident of Carmel Valley, was found guilty after a two-day jury trial of driving under the influence and driving with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or more.

On July 8, 2017, at about 1:30 a.m., Casas-Ramirez was seen by Carmel police officers running a stop sign and speeding on Ocean Avenue in Carmel. After the stop a DUI investigation was conducted and Casas-Ramirez was found to have a blood alcohol content of 0.13%.

The case was heard by Monterey County Superior Court Judge Rafael Vazquez. Casas-Ramirez will be sentenced on September 27, 2018 and faces up to 5 years probation and 6 months in jail.
