SALINAS MAN GUILTY OF SEXUAL BATTERY ON NURSE

People v Albert Nile Little; 18CR002071

SALINAS, California- Monterey County District Attorney Jeannine M. Pacioni announced today that Salinas resident, Albert Nile Little, age 58, was found guilty by jury of sexual battery for groping a nurse's breasts.

On February 3, 2018, Little, a patient at Natividad Hospital, was being attended to by one of his nurses when he groped her breasts and then smirked and told her "that was good for me". The nurse called police because this was not the first time he had molested a nurse at that hospital. Salinas Police Officer Terrel Bailey was dispatched and interviewed both Little and the nurse. Although Little was suffering from various physical and mental infirmities, he was mentally stable enough to tell Officer Bailey that he did it intentionally.

The case was heard by Judge Thomas Wills. Little was sentenced to three years' probation and ordered to register as a sex offender for life.
