Optimal Referrals (in order of PHRT priority)

Maternal-Child-Adolescent

Medically fragile infants (e.g., failure to thrive, developmental delay, congenital anomalies, etc.)

High Risk - Pregnancy

Pregnant and Parenting Teens

Prenatal and Postpartum Depression

Childhood Obesity

Gestational Diabetes\

Childhood Overweight and Obesity

Diabetes: Types I and II

Asthma

Cardiovascular: e.g. Hypertension, Dyslipidemia

Adult Obesity: BMI, between 35 - 45 with co-morbidities

Note: Adults must have two or more medical comorbidities

Referrals Declined

Bariatric Surgery/Lap Band Nutritional Consults

Lead

Autism or ADHD

Child Protective Services cases

(Cases of suspected abuse i.e., physical, sexual or emotional and suspected general or medical neglect)

Adult Protective Services

(Suspected dependent/elderly neglect or abuse)

Behavioral health issues

Adults BMI 25-34 (overweight and obese)

Lactation consult

Anemia *only*

Constipation *only*

Communicable Diseases: Sexually Transmitted Infections, TB, etc.

Visiting Nurses or other home health agency already involved

Lice, scabies, fleas
