SUD treatment providers contracting with Monterey County will demonstrate their ongoing commitment to implement evidence based treatment practices, ensuring that their employees receive training to meet this requirement. Evidence based practices currently utilized by our contracting providers include Motivational Interviewing, Seeking Safety, Trauma Informed-Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Matrix Model, Integrated Co-occurring Treatment, Thinking for a Change, and Seven Challenges.
