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Policy

The County of Monterey is not liable for employees or volunteers of the Behavioral Health Division who are involved in community activities in which they are not authorized agents of the County.

Procedure

Employees/volunteers involved in community activities are not considered to be agents of the Behavioral Health Division unless their involvement is part of their Divisional responsibility and has been officially sanctioned (an activity approved of by the respective agency as it complies with that agencies process of activity approval prior to that activity occurring) by the appropriate Behavioral Health Program Manager.

Employees and volunteers using their own time and resources in such organizations would not involve liability for the Behavioral Health Division in the event of mishap.

All employees of the Behavioral Health Division will refrain from using any County facility to promote any community activity or organization that is not a part of the Behavioral Health Division.
