Temporary Construction Hour Change for Arroyo Seco/River Road Work to Begin 10/8 and 10/14

Work crews are moving into a new phase of work on Arroyo Seco and River Roads which will require a temporary change in work hours at both locations.

On Arroyo Seco Road, work hours will change on 10/8/19 and last through 10/11/19. The change extends the hours. New hours are 4:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Normal work hours (6:00 am to 5:00 pm) will resume when this phase is complete.

On River Road, work hours will change on 10/14 and last through 10/24. The change extends the hours. New hours are 4:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Normal work hours (6:00 am to 5:00 pm) will resume when this phase is complete.

This phase will see Full Depth Reclamation work begin at these locations. During this process, crews will dig down 15 inches, bringing up materials that will be collected, recycled and reused with new material at the site to rebuild the roadway to last another 15 to 20 years

The work being done at these locations will improve roads heavily used by agribusiness and winery tourism. Public Works is coordinating with area growers to reduce impacts of the projects on harvesting activities.

Total cost for these projects is approximately \$7.5 million, which is a savings of an estimated \$1 million because the projects were put out to bid together and are being done simultaneously.

These projects are funded by SB1 and Measure X.
