EGCSO SHERIFF FUNDING

ACTION:

Report was presented and information communicated regarding allocation of taxes and the funding of public safety for East Garrison. Information regarding the property tax distribution during FY 2017-18 was provided. Information was provided regarding the process in determining EGCSO annual sheriff allocation.

N. Poling requested clarification on allocation being the same across the County and asked if EG is also subsidizing other parts of the County for Sheriff.

A question was asked what the Patrol Schedule is for East Garrison.

SHERIFF SERVICES FOR EGCS

Received a report on East Garrison Annual CSD Allocation to Sheriff; was presented to the Advisory Committee including the background, funding and determining Sheriff annual allocation.

CHP responds to vehicle code issues and Sheriff response to criminal code issues. Information regarding crime reports can be found at MontereySheriff.org

Sheriff response to East Garrison community has primarily been for alarm calls. In 2019, Sheriffs Office responded to 44 false alarm calls. Sheriff reminded residents that home alarms need to be registered with the Monterey County Sheriffs Office.

Sheriffs community outreach division can assist East Garrison residents with the community watch program.
