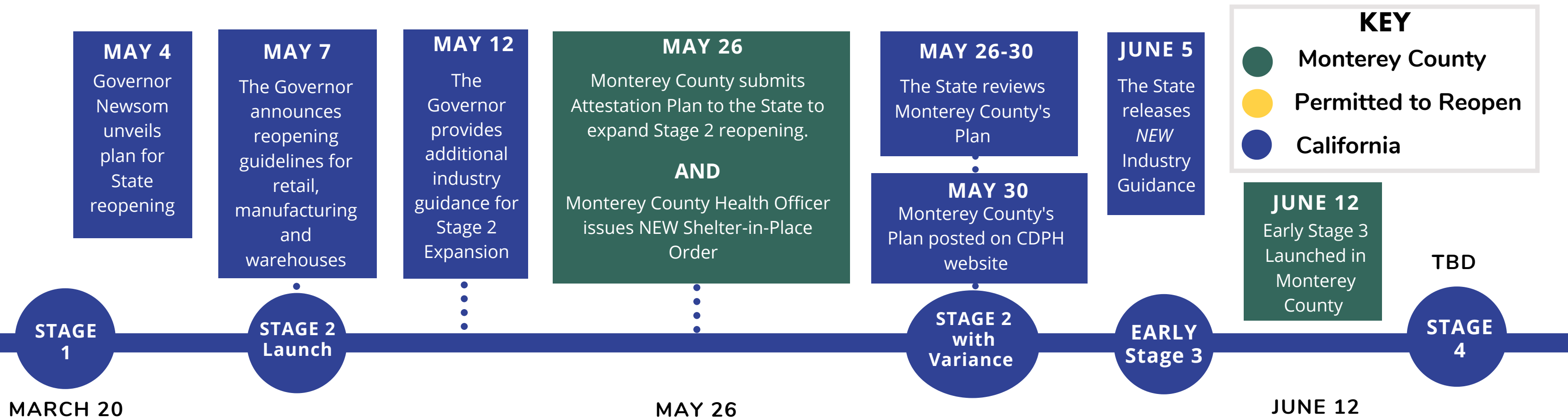


# WHAT'S NEXT FOR BUSINESS REOPENING?

### Stage 2

Lower Risk Workplaces Reopen with Safety Modifications

- Construction
- Landscape / gardening
- Childcare/ day camps
- Golfing and golf courses
- Schools with modifications
- Full service car washes
- In-person religious services
- Outdoor museums
- Public spaces
- Auto dealerships
- Dog grooming / dog walking services
- On-site retail / shopping malls / swap meets
- Residential cleaning and janitorial
- Office work spaces
- Real estate transactions
- Film, TV, and music production
- Pro Sports without live audience
- Curbside library services

**STAGE 2 with Variance**

- Dine-in restaurants
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Casinos

### Early Stage 3 with Variance

Higher Risk Workplaces Reopen with Safety Modifications

**Early STAGE 3 Launches on June 12**

- Movie theaters/family entertainment centers
- Wineries and bars
- Zoos and museums
- Gyms and fitness centers
- Hotels/Lodging for tourism
- Cardrooms/racetracks
- Campgrounds and outdoor recreation / pools

**Additional Services on June 19**

- Nail salons/tattoo parlors/body waxing/spas/Massage

**STAGE 3 NOT PERMITTED TO OPEN**

- Indoor and outdoor playgrounds
- Live theater / in-person higher education
- Saunas/steam rooms/hot tubs
