



**COVID-19 Protocols
for Campground Operations
6.19.20**

General:

- No group reservations allowed – only single households
- Facility does not have potable water. Campers must use bottled water for drinking and cooking.
- Updated policies and procedures will be posted on WeatherTechRaceway.com, as well as on the bulletin board near the Guest Booth.
- Playground to remain closed
- Non-registered visitors not permitted in Campgrounds
- COVID-19 signage posted at Guest Booth, message board, and all campground restrooms promoting 6 ft. social/physical distancing, facial covering and hygiene practices.

Control Measures:

- Temperature and symptom screenings will occur with all Camp Volunteers/Hosts prior to each shift. Symptoms of COVID-19 include frequent cough, fever (>100.4°F), difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, recent loss of taste or smell. If experiencing any of the above, volunteer is not to report for shift.
- All volunteers and associates of Laguna Seca Recreation Area are to wear face coverings when in close proximity to visitors and other staff.
- Volunteers will wear face coverings when working the Guest Booth.
- Acrylic shields installed at the entrance and exit windows of Guest Booth. Pens will be wiped down consistently. Disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer in place for both Camp Hosts and visitors.
- Visitors with reservations to be contacted prior to their scheduled arrival to confirm the reservation and ask if they or someone in their household is exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms. If the visitor answers in the affirmative, reschedule or cancel the reservation without penalty. Ensure visitors with reservations are aware of policies prior to arrival so they have the appropriate PPE when they check in.
- Campground protocols have been placed on WeatherTechRaceway.com and will be handed out to every guest upon check-in.
- Practice social/physical distancing
 - Wear face coverings if leaving the boundaries of your campsite
- Guests are encouraged to utilize their own RV/trailer for showering, restroom use, cooking, etc. If using outdoor picnic tables, we recommend guests bring their own vinyl table covering for easy cleaning and disinfecting.

Cleaning & Disinfecting:

- Park Attendants to clean electrical panels and water spickets, located in individual campsites, after each check-out.
- Dump Station to be cleaned and disinfected each day and volunteer staff to wipe down the equipment after each use.
- Restrooms / Showers will be cleaned and disinfected three times per day, morning, afternoon and evening. A log will be kept on the back of each restroom door, indicating when it was cleaned.
- Doors to restrooms to remain closed at all times. Hardware to be disinfected each time restrooms are cleaned.
- Hand sanitizer stations installed at the entrance of each restroom.
- Park Attendants have been trained on the proper use of all-purpose cleaners and disinfectants.
