ROYAL OAKS MAN FOUND GUILTY OF RESISTING AN OFFICER

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flippo announced today that on November 18, 2015, Alonso Torres, age 52, a resident of Royal Oaks, was found guilty in a court trial of resisting and delaying an officer. The case was heard by Monterey County Superior Court Judge Vanessa Vallarta.

On March 4, 2015, Monterey County Sheriff's Deputy Jason Sullivan attempted to conduct a traffic stop. When the vehicle pulled over, Torres exited the passenger side of the vehicle and began to walk away. The deputy ordered Torres to get back inside the vehicle. However, Torres refused to comply and ignored the deputy. Deputy Sullivan attempted to detain Torres who physically resisted and attempted to get free.

Judge Vallarta sentenced Torres to three years of probation.
